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DALLAS (September 21, 2026) – The Perot Museum of Nature and Science's signature fundraising event, ***Night at the Museum***, returns on Saturday, November 14, 2026, bringing together supporters, community leaders and Museum advocates for an unforgettable evening of exploration, wonder and possibility.

More than an evening of celebration, *Night at the Museum* is one of the Perot Museum's most powerful opportunities for the community to come together around the Museum's mission to expand access to science and discovery.
